David Haas Coming to our Diocese

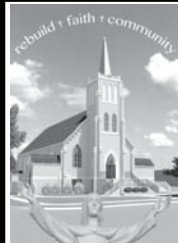

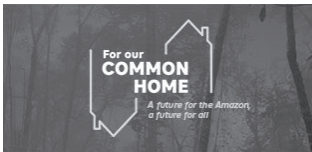

DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE FALL CAMPAIGN

In 2015, Pope Francis alerted us to the importance of protecting our common home in his encyclical *Laudato Si'*. He invited us to greater responsibility and urgent action. The theme of this year's Fall Campaign is "For Our Common Home". The slogan, and the motif of upright and inverted houses, suggest that both the North and the South are interconnected and share a common home — the Earth. The focus this year is on the Amazon, an area of the world in recent news. The native Amazonian peoples have probably never been so threatened on their own lands as they are now." - *Pope Francis, Peru, January 2018*.
