MASSES BEGIN SUNDAY, JUNE 28TH, 2020

Fr. Rick will be celebrating his last Mass at both parishes on this day ~ 8:30am Harrow and 11:00am Kingsville. Only 30% capacity will be allowed in the church, and in order to manage that you must reserve your seat prior to that weekend. For June 28th Mass—we only have spots left at the Harrow 8:30am Mass. Reservations are being taken up to 12 noon on the Friday before that weekend's Mass unless it is already full. Then your name will be entered on the next weekend Mass. You will need to take your temperature before you come, if over 100, please stay home. You must wear a mask and arrive at least 15-30 minutes prior to Mass to be seated. There will be no bathroom facilities available for public use.

Pastor's Message

June, 2020

Dear Parishioners,

It seems strange having had over 3 ½ months since the onset of COVID-19 and preparing for my retirement and departure, that I find it difficult to choose the proper words in expressing my feelings as I bid you farewell. I guess it's never easy to say good-bye regardless how much time you have to prepare.

I had hoped that I would have had the opportunity to say most of this at the farewell gathering that was planned for the 21st of June but COVID- 19 put an end to that, (or has postponed it to some time in the future). Then, with the announcement of our places of worship re-opening sooner than many of us had expected and with all the restrictions in doing so, my verbal message would only reach 30% of the congregation-if that. So, I utilize the trusty parish bulletin hoping it will reach a few more.

In July of 2007, I embarked on a new venture of becoming the first pastor of the newly created cluster parishes of St. Anthony of Padua, Harrow; St. John de Brebeuf, Kingsville; and Our Lady Star of the Sea, Pelee Island.

Now, in June of 2020, I complete 13 years as your pastor, having enjoyed a total of 45 years of active priestly ministry and 70 years of living a happy and grace-filled life. That's a lot of numbers, a lot of years and a lot of memories- mostly happy with a few sad ones thrown into the mix.

It's not my intention to make this long and drawn out, as I do hope there will be another time when I will be able to return and have the opportunity to see you face to face and to say farewell properly.

However, please know how grateful and blessed I have been to have been with you and your families all these years. Whether at the Eucharistic liturgies, the celebration of sacraments, anniversaries, graduations, parish picnics, hospital visits and the list goes on—it's been a gift to be a part of you and your family's lives.

I also owe a profound thank you to all the pastoral team, past and present; the office staff; caretakers; organists; and the many priests, especially my good friend, Fr. Michael O'Brien who covered allowing me to get away on holiday.

Now, let me just say, it's a sure thing that I have forgotten someone or two or three individuals. There are many involved in parish ministries such as readers, choir members, Eucharistic Ministers, servers, money counters, ushers, sacristans, altar servers, children's liturgy ministers, CWL, Knights, St. Vincent de Paul, and the list goes on. Not to have acknowledged you all by name was deliberate because I didn't want to leave anyone out. I hope to do so at a later time.

Please know that ALL of you, parishioners and staff past and present, have and will always hold a special place in my heart and mind. I look forward to seeing you when the cloud of COVID-19 lifts.

May the Lord shower His choicest graces upon you and guide you to happiness everyday of your life.

Prayer and Worship

Our family of faith is one that recognizes the importance of prayer in all that we do. Prayer is the common bond that we share as a family, regardless of our language, age or geographic location. From the child praying before bed to the prayer group at the parish, our family of faith continues to pray for those in our community and those around the world. Everyone is called to live a "vital and personal relationship with the living and true God. This relationship is prayer." *Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2558*

We can pray alone or with others; we worship together as parish communities at Mass and pray as families. There are many types of prayer and many different styles of worship, but all center on living and experiencing our relationship with the living God.

Four basic elements...

- Blessing and Adoration (praising God)
- Prayer of Petition (asking for what we need, including forgiveness)
- Prayer of Intercession (asking for what others need)
- Prayer of Thanksgiving (for what God has given and done)

Tips for praying:

- Find a quiet place and time
- Calm yourself and put away distractions
- Speak what you feel to God, or use set prayers
- Take time to listen
- Use the Bible in your prayer
- Consider keeping a prayer journal

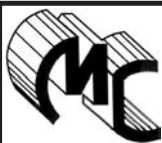
