REMEMBER ST. MALACHY IN YOUR WILL!

**FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR**

“Almost Married”

Occasionally I’ve heard young people describe themselves as “almost married.” It’s an amusing phrase, because of course you’re not really married at all until you’re wholly married. There’s no such state as mostly-married! But you know what they mean: They mean they are (or were) on the way, the time until the anticipated marriage grows short, and maybe they feel twinges of impatience or anxiety.

So it is with the RockKenRo parishes: We’re almost married. By the time you read this bulletin we will have concluded the six parish assemblies concerning consolidation, and pastoral and finance council meetings for each of Holy Trinity, St. John of God, and St. Malachy Parishes. At the council meetings, we discussed the assemblies and over 300 written responses. Unless something unexpected turned up before October 11, I likely submitted to Bishop Zubik a petition to consolidate the three parishes into one parish.

If so, Bishop Zubik will take the petition to the Presbyteral Council and perhaps other consultative bodies for review. He will then decide whether or not to grant the petition. I would expect to hear in December from him about this and also the new name of the emergent parish.

If Bishop Zubik grants the petition, the three parishes become one in a kind of “Brady Bunch” marriage: The newly emergent parish inherits everything from its predecessors—four church buildings, three school buildings, the Mother of Sorrows social hall, the rectories, staff, assets, debts, ministries, and missions.

The consolidation will make it possible for our ministry to be more effective and efficient. Meanwhile, we’ll examine our potential for otherwise increasing our revenues or decreasing our expenses. I’ve begun a revenue analysis, and Dave Hess at Holy Trinity has already established an inter-parish cost-cutting team.

One cost is the multiplicity of bulletins. Starting next Sunday, October 20, we’ll cut down from three separate parish bulletins to one combined “RockKenRo” bulletin. We’ll work out the new process in part by trial and error, so please be patient with our staff.
