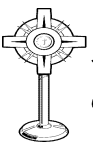

**FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR**  
**Consolidation and Parish Assemblies**

Already last January, after discussions with the various pastoral and finance councils of Holy Trinity, St. John of God, and St. Malachy, I knew we needed to study the possibility of a consolidation of the RockKenRo parishes. Through more recent consultation, I've been assembling the data I need to make a responsible decision, but the data are incomplete until I hear your insight, too. I will therefore be sharing my view with you in a series of parish assemblies next month:

- St. Malachy: September 14 at 5:15 p.m. or September 15 at 12:15 p.m.
- St. John of God: September 21 at 5:45 p.m. or September 22 at 11:00 a.m.
- Holy Trinity: September 28 at 6:15 p.m. or September 29 at 1:15 p.m.

At these assemblies, you'll be presented with both quantitative and qualitative data. I expect the quantitative data to include:

<i>Mass attendance</i>	<i>Registration &amp; age distributions</i>	<i>Parish Share Program statistics</i>
<i>Seating capacity</i>	<i>Church distances &amp; travel times</i>	<i>Assets &amp; liabilities in cash</i>
<i>Baptisms/marriages/deaths</i>	<i>Parishioner residence maps</i>	<i>Property snapshots</i>
<i>Staffing profiles</i>	<i>Operating income &amp; expense</i>	<i>Potential for shared ministry</i>

The qualitative data will be a pastoral description\* of each parish. It's important for us to remember that we are not just numbers and statistics. There's a personal and social reality behind and beyond the numbers, and we ought not lose sight of it.

At each assembly, you'll have an opportunity for clarifying questions, and an opportunity to provide written feedback. Your feedback will be accepted at any assembly, even if not in your home parish.

The criteria for consolidation are whether it advances our administration of the sacraments, our care of souls, and our responsible stewardship of time, talent, and treasure entrusted to us by God. It would mean I ask Bishop Zubik to make our three parishes into one parish under a new name. The new parish would inherit everything from its predecessors: churches, rectories, school buildings, parking lots, equipment, supplies, bank accounts, debts, staff, ministries, future bequests, and past obligations.

Parish consolidation is *not* the same thing as church closing. All things being equal, a consolidated parish would continue to use the churches as the three do now. Parish consolidation, however, may make it easier to make changes that advance our mission and good stewardship. I envision, for example, that it might enable me to reduce the number of Sunday Masses with minimum harm to the community. So please pray that we all remain open to the will of our Lord and the movement of his Holy Spirit.
