## INTRODUCTION

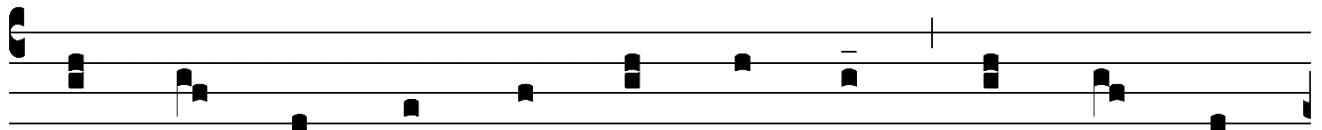
