

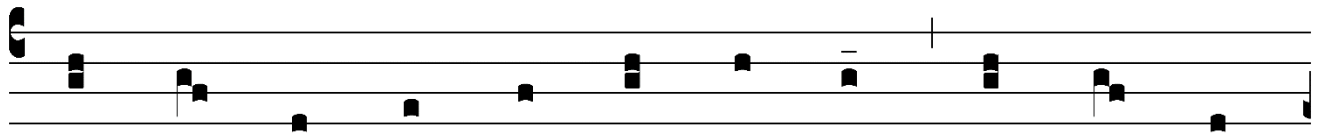

INTRODUCTION

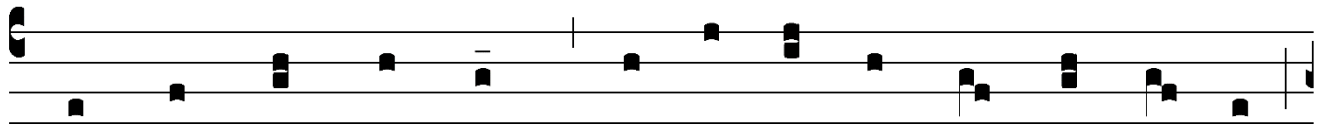
God, + come to my assistance.
