The Board is made up of parishioners, parents, alumni, small business owners, teachers and members of many other areas of business and expertise. The Board is made up of people that believe in the value and benefits of a Catholic education and want to see it grow.

The Board is tasked with overseeing the financial well-being of the school, to develop a sustainable budget which promotes growth, insure that the physical structure of the school is maintained and work to not only maintain our school's enrollment, but increase it. This is done through the various Board committees: Development (fundraising), Enrollment, Finance, Facilities and Membership.

As a Board member, responsibilities are as follows:

- The Board meets as a group four (4) times a year. Presence is essential at these meetings as committee proposals and issues are discussed and voted on.
- Each Board member joins one of the committees: Development (fundraising), Enrollment, Financial, Facilities or Membership.
- Committee meetings are held sometime before the scheduled Board meeting. The committees vet out and submit proposals to the Board for approval.
