

Stay at Home BINGO

Directions

1. Download the appropriate BINGO board for your child's age.
2. To begin participating, have children take a picture with their BINGO board (either printed or showing on a screen).
 - Email the picture to kraaen@churchofsttimothy.com to begin playing
 - This is the free space in the middle of the board
 - Please include in the email if you give permission for me to use the photos (names are never included)
3. Have children choose different squares on the BINGO board to complete.
 - If the square requires the reading of a Bible story:
 - Use your own children's Bibles or storybooks
 - Read from the Bible
 - Use one of the links provided on the following page, or ones you find on your own
 - For many stories, you can also find videos on YouTube (be sure to preview all videos)
4. Each time your child completes a square, have them take a picture with the final product to submit.
 - If the activity does not have a concrete final product, have them take a picture with the Bible story they read
5. I will keep track of each submission. Prizes will be awarded for BINGOs achieved.
