<p><b>God Made the World</b></p> <p>Take a nature walk.</p> <p>Use objects you find (sticks, pebbles, leaves) to make a work of art.</p> <p>Thank God for creating the world.</p>	<p><b>Noah and the Ark</b></p> <p>Read the story of Noah.</p> <p>God placed the rainbow in the sky as a promise never to flood the earth again.</p> <p>Make your own unique rainbow.</p>	<p><b>Prayer Journal</b></p> <p>Use a notebook or loose papers to make a prayer journal. Decorate the cover.</p> <p>Write or draw a prayer in your journal each night. What would you like to pray for?</p>	<p><b>Moses</b></p> <p>Read the story of Moses.</p> <p>Make a board game to help the Israelites escape Egypt. Play game.</p>	<p><b>Movie</b></p> <p>Find a video of a Bible story and watch with your family.</p> <p>This could be a video you have (<i>Prince of Egypt, Veggie Tales, etc.</i>) or you can look online.</p>
<p><b>Jesus' Baptism</b></p> <p>Read the story of Jesus' baptism.</p> <p>Talk about your baptism. Who are your godparents? Do you have anything special from your baptism?</p>	<p><b>Illustrate a Bible Verse</b></p> <p>Pick a verse from the Bible that you can see.</p> <p>Write the verse on a piece of paper and illustrate it. Make me see what you see.</p>	<p><b>Joshua</b></p> <p>Read Joshua 6: 1-27, the fall of Jericho.</p> <p>Build a model of Jericho with Legos or blocks and act out the story.</p>	<p><b>Esther</b></p> <p>Read the story of Esther.</p> <p>What did Esther do that was so brave?</p> <p>How did she find the strength to be brave?</p>	<p><b>Prayer Walk</b></p> <p>Go for a walk as a family.</p> <p>Talk about the different things you can pray for on the walk.</p>
<p><b>Disciple Hopscotch</b></p> <p>Draw out a hopscotch outline. Instead of numbering squares, write the names of the disciples. Practice saying the names as you play.</p>	<p><b>Zacchaeus</b></p> <p>Read the story of Zacchaeus.</p> <p>Act out the story using dolls or stuffed animals.</p>	<p><b>Take a picture of yourself with your BINGO board to begin playing!</b></p>	<p><b>Color Prayer</b></p> <p>What is your favorite color?</p> <p>Make a list of all the things you can think of that are that color.</p> <p>Pray for all the things on your list.</p>	<p><b>Sing</b></p> <p>Look up and learn a new Bible song.</p> <p>Record yourself singing the song.</p>
<p><b>Daniel &amp; the Lions</b></p> <p>Read the story of Daniel in the Lion's Den.</p> <p>Use the couch cushions to create a lion's den of your own. Go inside and pray.</p>	<p><b>Storybook</b></p> <p>Read a Bible story, any story you choose.</p> <p>Draw a picture illustrating the story</p>	<p><b>Bible Dress Up</b></p> <p>Pick your favorite person from the Bible and dress up as them.</p> <p>Read the story while dressed up.</p>	<p><b>Jonah</b></p> <p>Read the story of Jonah.</p> <p>Make a water globe (like a snow globe) with a whale inside.</p> <p>Add blue food coloring to the water.</p>	<p><b>Washing of the Feet</b></p> <p>Read John 13:1-20</p> <p>As a family, sit down and wash each other's feet. Take the time to care for each other, as Jesus cared for his disciples</p>
<p><b>Prayer Chain</b></p> <p>For one week, work on a prayer chain.</p> <p>Cut strips of paper for a paper chain. Each day, write a prayer on a strip and connect the chain. This is a good family activity.</p>	<p><b>The Prodigal Son</b></p> <p>Read the story of the Prodigal Son.</p> <p>Why does the father forgive his son?</p> <p>What lesson does the son learn?</p>	<p><b>Flower Prayer</b></p> <p>Pick a flower and say a prayer for a different person on each petal. Keep the flower to remind you of those people.</p>	<p><b>Palm Sunday</b></p> <p>Read the story of Jesus entering Jerusalem.</p> <p>Act out Jesus' welcome into Jerusalem.</p>	<p><b>Bible Story Request</b></p> <p>Ask your parents to read you a Bible story of your choice.</p> <p>Draw a picture of what happens in the story.</p>
