



A Brief History:

For many years there was no Catholic Church in Linden and Catholic families in the area traveled to Stockton or to Lockeford to attend Mass. In 1882, Linden was designated a mission of St. Joachim's by Archbishop Alemany of the Archdiocese of San Francisco and remained under its authority until 1904. Father Kennedy was the priest serving this area in 1882. He was succeeded by Father Cassin in 1883, under whose leadership the first Holy Cross Church was built on the current parish property. It is presently being used as the church hall and classroom.

Fr. Maisano was instrumental in building the present day Holy Cross Church which was dedicated in 1953 by Bishop Guifoyle. In 1959, Fr. Meyer became pastor of both St. Michael's and Holy Cross. In 1962, Holy Cross Catholic Church became a parish.
