There will be no daily Mass December 31 – January 4. Chapel offices will also be on a half-day schedule during that time period, open from 0830-1230.

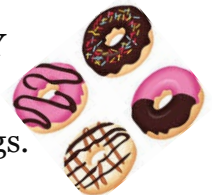


Pre-Baptism Class

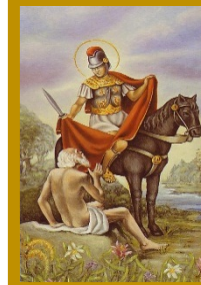
