Join us for this uniquely Catholic tradition.

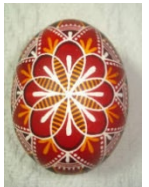

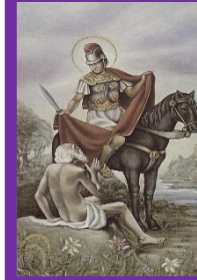
