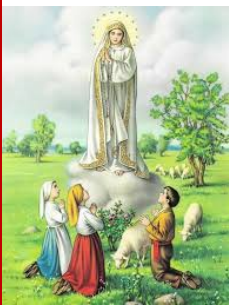


Our Lady of Fatima Marian Prayer Service

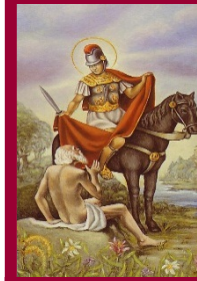

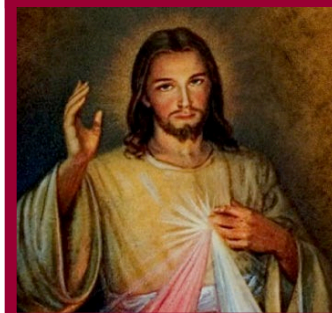

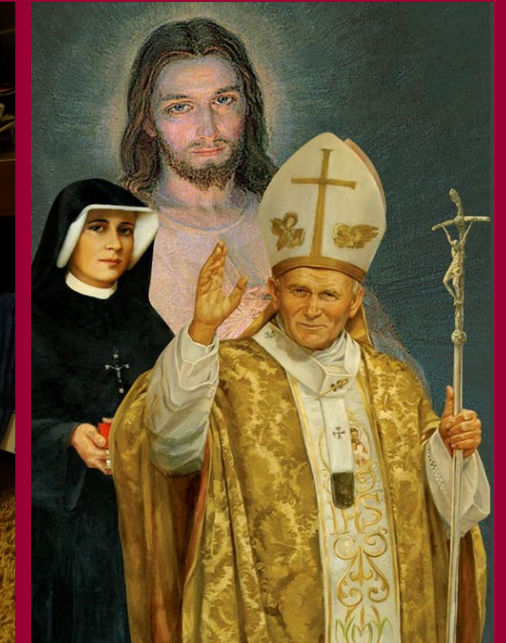
