

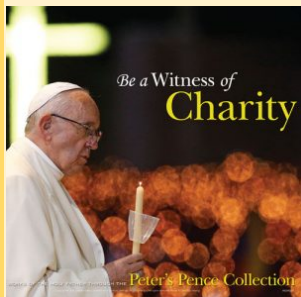

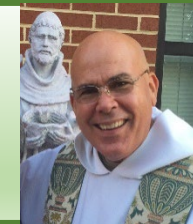
Reservation forms are available at the back of each chapel. This retreat is a free event.

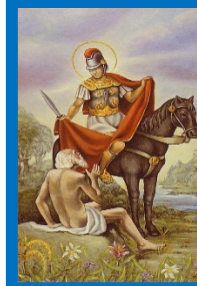
