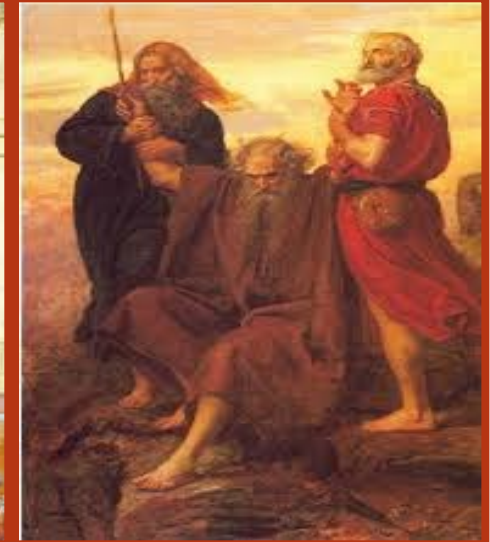

### Sacrament of Baptism



Parents who would like their children baptized at Fort Belvoir must first attend a Pre-Baptism Class. These classes are held every first Saturday of the month.
