Dear Bishop Baraga Families,

Today I received word from a parent that they have tested positive for COVID-19. Their children are in grades kindergarten, second, third, and fourth. The children have not been in school since Friday and were not exhibiting any symptoms. The family is doing well. Let's keep them in our prayers for a speedy recovery. If any of the children test positive for COVID-19 I will let you know.

Below I would like to share our quarantine policy. This is written with an abundance of caution to ensure the health and safety of our students, staff and families.

If a parent/guardian/adult in the home tests positive:

- You must keep your children home.
- Once you are asymptomatic your children's quarantine begins.
- Your children must quarantine for 10 days from the time the longest recovering parent is asymptomatic.
- Example: If a parent tests positive and has symptoms for 10 days, on the 11th day the children begin their 10-day quarantine.

If a parent tests positive and can separate from the children:

- The children's 10-day quarantine begins when the parent separates from the child.

If a student tests positive:

- They are quarantined for a minimum of 7 days.
- They must be asymptomatic for 72 hours before returning to school.

Please give me a call if you have any questions regarding this policy. Please remember that symptoms are often very mild in children. Please be vigilant and keep your children home even if they only have mild cold symptoms.

Please be assured of my prayers for you and your families.
