Dear Bishop Baraga Families,

Today I received word from one of our parents that they have tested positive for COVID-19. They have students in pre-kindergarten, fourth grade, and sixth grade. The pre-kindergarten students have not been to school since last Thursday and the fourth and sixth grade students have not been to school since Friday. None of the children were exhibiting any symptoms while at school. I will let you know if any of these students test positive. Please keep them in your prayers.

We have not had a student test positive yet, but if that happens, we will contact the other members of that student's cohort and at the same time we will work with the Dickinson-Iron Health Department to determine if any students in the cohort are considered a close contact. It may be necessary to have a class stay home to give the Health Department the necessary time to do contact tracing. This could happen at any time, so parents should be prepared for last minute schedule changes.

Just a reminder that parent-teacher conferences are this Thursday. That means dismissal is at 12:00 p.m. Conferences will start at 1:00 p.m. If you have not signed up for a conference, please login to your account on SchoolSpeak and do so. You may also call the office and we will sign you up. Conferences will either be a virtual meeting or a phone call.
