

DRESS CODE: Kindergarten – Eighth Grade

*Uniforms are not required for preschool and pre-k students.

Boys: Grades K – 8th Grade**Girls: Grades K – 8th Grade**

Shirts *Collared shirt / polo or oxford style *Solid in color / white, light blue, royal blue, dark blue *Short or long sleeved *Collar must be worn down *BBCS Jacket / sweaters / sweater vests *Cardigans – can be worn over collared shirt, must be solid in color / white, light blue, royal blue, dark blue	Shirts *Collared shirt / polo or oxford style *Solid in color / white, light blue, royal blue, dark blue *Short or long sleeved *Collar must be worn down *BBCS Jacket / sweaters / sweater vests *Cardigans – can be worn over collared shirt, must be solid in color / white, light blue, royal blue, dark blue
Bottoms / Pants: *Khaki, corduroy, or dress pants *Solid navy or tan in color *straight leg, no skinny style pants *Waist of the pants must be above the student’s hipbones	Bottoms / Pants: *Khaki, corduroy, or dress pants *Solid navy or tan in color *Straight leg, no skinny style pants *Waist of the pants must be above the student’s hipbones
Bottoms / Shorts: *Shorts allowed August, September, May, and June ONLY *Khaki, solid navy, or tan dress shorts *Knee length	Bottoms / Dresses / Skirts: *Knee length uniform <u>clear blue plaid</u> jumper or skirt (available from Land’s End) *Leggings, tights, knee socks, low socks can be worn under skirt / jumper. Should be navy or white in color.
	Bottoms / Shorts: *Shorts allowed August, September, May and June ONLY *Khaki, solid, navy, or tan dress shorts *Knee length

All School Uniform Policies

Footwear K-8 *Footwear is at the discretion of parents *No open-toed shoes for safety reasons *All shoes must have a backing *No flip flops	Clothing for Mass *Students are NOT allowed to wear shorts to Mass. *Students may change into shorts after Mass once they are back at school. *Students are NOT allowed to wear sweatshirts of any kind during Mass. If worn as a jacket it must be removed for Mass.
Dress Down Days *Periodically students will have the opportunity to participate in dress down days. *Non-uniform clothing can be worn: jeans, pants, t-shirts. *Some dress down days will be spirit days. Students can wear BBCS Trekker t-shirts.	Violation of Dress Code/Not limited to the list below: *T-shirts *Sweatshirts including hoodies *Cargo pants (pockets, zippers on the legs) *Jeans *Holes in clothing

Dress Code Enforcement:

- Policy will be monitored and enforced by all Bishop Baraga Catholic School Staff.
- The principal has the final say on all dress code matters.

Consequences for dress code violation:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning sent home to parents
- Call home to parents
- Student sent home to change into correct uniform
