

Altar Server Registration

Adults, teens, and children (who are in the 4th grade and up and who have received First Eucharist) are eligible to be Altar Servers.

The Altar Servers form a very important part of the church and every parish is enriched through their dedication and service. It is a very important responsibility, and requires a sincere commitment. Only if you are serious about the commitment your child/you are about to make, should you apply to be an Altar Server. Parents, your signature on the registration form indicates your agreement to this commitment.

Altar Servers usually meet for instruction and practice the second and fourth Mondays of each month in the Church. Please consult bulletin for the next date.
