FROM THE BISHOP

As you maybe aware Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has announced a Synod entitled For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission, which will commence on October 10, 2021 and conclude with the convening of an in person gathering from around the world in Rome in October 2023.

This Synod's purpose is to lead the whole Church into a deeper understanding of our mission in the world. Bishops, priests and deacons will organize and attend meetings in every diocese around the world with the purpose of listening to the concerns, the joys, the frustrations, the ideas and even the anger of the faithful related to the Catholic Church today and where they suggest it should move toward tomorrow. We will remain true to the Church Doctrine, Dogma and the guidance of the Doctors of the Church.

The Synod, by direction of our Holy Father, begins at diocesan level on the weekend of October 16-17, 2021 and concludes at the local level in April 2022. Within this timeframe, every diocese is to convene meetings at the local level and then regional levels, culminating in a written report (Synthesis) summarizing the discussions within the meetings in April 2022. As soon as we receive the guidelines for the opening Mass for the Synod on the weekend of Oct. 16-17 our Office of Worship will share them with all priests to assist you in planning parish liturgies that weekend.
