



Dear Parents/Guardians:

The purpose of Catholic schools is to strengthen, develop and secure the future of the Catholic Church and its teachings.

For this reason, parishes will subsidize Holy Rosary Regional Catholic School families one thousand dollars per child. In return, the parishes reasonably expect parents to regularly attend Mass with their children and to regularly support the parish financially.

This formula of faith-filled cooperation is fostered and encouraged by the archdioceses and is noted in our school handbook.

Each Pastor has a moral responsibility to the rest of his parishioners to use their contributions in the advancement of the Faith. Therefore, pastors are permitted to deny subsidy to any school family who does not regularly attend Mass in his parish nor financially support that parish.

Non-churchgoing and non-contributing families should expect to pay one thousand dollars more per child than the tuition committed parishioners pay.

The reverse side of this letter is to be signed by the family's Pastor in order to complete a child's registration in Holy Rosary Regional School.
