The 2019-2020 academic year started with 307 students from preschool to grade nine. The students have a safe environment and they look forward to attending school. Joyfully, our pioneers will graduate this summer and we are looking forward to good grades from each of them on the high school government exams.

Last May we completed the bakery which currently serves students bread for breakfast. We are looking forward to harvesting fish coupled with eggs from the poultry to further the nutrition of the children. The bread, fish, and eggs that are not needed for the children are sold to the community for the school's financial sustainability.

The staff housing project is on a steady construction. We hope to complete it next year if our financial needs are met accordingly. The completion will be extremely helpful in retaining quality teachers in our rural village and school. This staff project will house close to 32 teachers. Each unit will require \$850 to complete and furnish.

We have reached this far with your ongoing support and prayers. As matter of fact, sponsoring of students is a 'life line' and the oxygen for the school. You are making a huge difference in the lives of these children. We are counting on your continuous support. We owe you a huge debt of gratitude and appreciation. The kids have hope because of you!
