Report of meetings and/or activities conducted by your committee since your last report: CCW has continued to take charge of sanitizing the church, Narthex, hearing aids, restrooms and doors after Sunday and weekday Masses, and on First Saturdays.

On August 20 a Board meeting was held at the gazebo at LST for social distancing. In the future Board meetings will take place on third Thursdays in Sheehan Hall.

Report of activity(s) to be conducted in the future: A September 9 General Meeting will be held in the church with the Blessed Sacrament being removed after Mass. Installation of officers will take place at 8:00 Mass. The Board decided to suspend General Meetings through the COVID pandemic and that will be announced at our September meeting. The annual Christmas luncheon at Legends will not take place. We are continuing our support for Habitat for Humanity and Drew Crabtree, our seminarian. We are encouraging ladies of the parish to continue considering second Wednesday as CCW day by attending daily Mass wearing our blue scarves. We will soon have the opportunity to record our service hours online so we can continue to report those to the diocese.
