A concrete “foot” has been poured on the southwest area outside the church for the AC units.
- After consultation with the Diocese, Deacon Doug and I have concluded that we will not have Communion Services at the Lake McDonald Lodge Community Building this year. Glacier is limiting in its opening processes. It would be well for the safety of all involved, visitors, extraordinary ministers, and everyone.
- The K of C is happy to announce that we will proceed with the Swap Meet and Car Show on June 20<sup>th</sup>, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. All safety measures will be observed! It will be a great way for the community to reconnect on our 5 acre parcel of land behind St. R!
