Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all those 18 through 59. Fasting means one regular meal at lunch and 2 smaller meals at breakfast and dinner. Abstinence from meat is observed by those 14 and older on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. (Pork, Sausage, Bacon, Venison, Chicken and Turkey are considered meat). Although people 60 and older are not required to fast, they are still required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of Lent.

Por esas personas de 60 años y mayor, no son obligados de ayunar; pero todavía son obligados de no comer carne en el Miércoles de Ceniza y todos los Viernes de Cuaresma.
