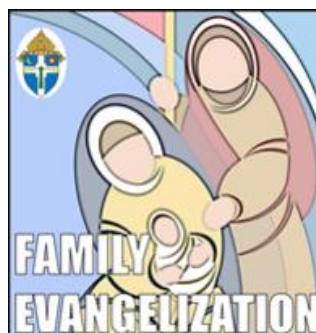
## PRAYER, FASTING, ALMSGIVING
