Now, more than ever we need the renewal of our sacraments for the spiritual nourishment of our souls to remain steadfast in our relationship with Jesus. With COVID-19 still very much a threat to our health, families, communities and our parish, we must continue to follow the guideline set forth by our local and state authorities and keep our faith, trusting that God will not abandon us and he is in control.

Today's reading offers three significant messages: • *Fear cannot prevent us from proclaiming the gospel and its demands.* • *Jesus promises that we will never be alone in our efforts to do what is right.* • *The final judgment before God will be based on the disciples' faithfulness to Jesus during the controversies that are part of their mission.*

In today's Gospel Jesus wraps up his teaching on what to fear by having the disciples imagine that moment when each of them will stand on his or her own before the Father and hear him say either, "This is my faithful disciple," or "This one is not mine." What Jesus will say about us depends on how

faithful we are daily to the unique mission for which God calls us to live.

As we reflect on today's Gospel, let's ask ourselves, What fears keep me from sharing my faith in God? Ridicule, criticism, loss of job or status, rejection, etc.? Have I ever given in to the pressure of my peers or unethical behavior because, "everyone else is doing it," or, "No one will ever know?"

What an amazing gift we have with the Holy Eucharist. We have a merciful God who is waiting for us without reservations. He waits for us to have a loving relationship with Jesus and our blessed mother. Do we have the desire to answer his call? Through the sacrament of reconciliation, we are cleansed of our sins and given yet another chance at being whole again, and live as his faithful servants.
