



Are you practicing good hospitality? When we are welcoming to others, give an act of kindness, share food or perhaps just simply take time to listen

to them, we experience the joy of the discipleship of God.

Today's readings and Gospel reflect on the practice of Hospitality. The benefits we gain by our practice of good hospitality are great. The first half of these sayings of Jesus are about the behavior of his disciples; the second half are about the behavior of others towards the disciples.

Elisha who enjoys the hospitality of a kind woman of influence displays a wonderful example of his response to the act of her hospitality. The woman with her aging husband were childless and had no idea of the rewards from their hospitality. After several stops and dining with her she identifies Elisha as "a holy man of God". Elisha promises that by the same time the next year she will be fondling a baby son. The elements of the story are quite ordinary: a frequent traveler, a kind but childless couple, hospitality, promise and hope.

2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16a

In the second reading today, we are reminded about the significance of our Sacrament of Baptism. We, as Christians must realize that Baptism is a life-changing event. We took a new identity when we were baptized. We are no longer Mary or John, but rather Mary-in-Christ and John-in-Christ. As we start adopting the will and ways of the Risen Lord, we are transformed into him. Sin becomes less attractive and we experience the joy of Christ's energy flowing through us as we give it our all-in doing God's work. Consequently,

we must think of ourselves as dead to sin and living for God in Christ-Jesus.

Roman 6:3-4, 8-11

In summary, the Gospel teaches us how to be disciples of Jesus. First, they must love him with all their hearts. They must pick up their cross and follow him and trust that no matter what happens he and the Father will take care of them. He tells us how this new life materializes in the interaction with the disciples and those who provide for their needs. In reference back to the first reading six repetitions of "receive or welcome" trace this process. Those who welcome a disciple welcome Jesus. Mathew emphasizes this point, a version of Jesus' teaching that what people do to other they do to him. If you welcome them, also welcome the Father and him will reward them. Matthew 10:37-42
