We know that is true because how often do we seek happiness but never find it because we are, as the song says, "Looking for love in all the wrong places." Our hearts will be restless and unsatisfied until they rest with the Lord.

In Psalm 145, we are reminded that the Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and compassionate. forgives He all our transgressions before we even ask for forgives. Most humans do not do this. Often, we have to beg for forgiveness from our brothers and sisters, even for minor misdeeds or sometimes for something we may not even have done. Not so with our Lord. His love is endless and unconditional.

As Saint Paul reminds the Romans, and us, nothing can separate us from the love of He gives us many juxtaposed Christ. comparisons such as life and death, present and future things, but the answer is the same: none of these things can separate us from God.

St. Matthew's Gospel tells the story of the five loaves and two fish that Jesus uses feed thousands of people. His disciples had told Jesus to send away the



crowd of thousands that had gathered to hear His word so that they might go eat elsewhere but Jesus says, no, you feed them. disciples are shocked because they have only five loaves and two fish and see no way to feed everyone. As we know, Jesus performed a miracle and not only did thousands eat with this food but there were twelve wicker baskets full of leftover fragments. Again, Jesus showing His infinite mercy, kindness and compassion. Let us open our hearts, still our thoughts and unite in acceptance thanksgiving for all the Lord's peace and love for us each and every moment of our lives. Jesus is Divine.

Lord, we love You and trust in You. As Disciples of Christ we have opportunities everyday to answer his call. Will we be open to say yes and answer his call today?


