<p><i>Sign of the Cross:</i></p>	
<p>In nómine Patris et Fílii et Spíritus Sancti. Amen.</p>	<p>In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.</p>
<p><i>Apostles' Creed:</i></p>	
<p>Credo in Deum Patrem omnipoténtem, Creatórem cæli et terræ. Et in Jesum Christum, Fílium eius únicum, Dóminum nostrum, qui concéptus est de Spíritu Sancto, natus ex María Vírgine, passus sub Póntio Piláto, crucifíxus, mórtuus, et sepúltus, descéndit ad ínfernos, tértia die resurréxit a mórtuis, ascéndit ad cælos, sedet ad dexteram Dei Patris omnipoténtis, inde ventúrus est iudicáre vivos et mórtuos. Credo in Spíritum Sanctum, sanctam Ecclésiám cathólicam, sanctórum communiómem, remissiómem peccatórum, carnis resurrectiómem, vitam ætérrnam. Panem nostrum quotidiánum da nobis hódie, et dimitte nobis débita nostra sicut et nos dimittimus debitóribus nostris. Et ne nos indúcas in tentatiómem, sed libera nos a malo. Amen.</p>	<p>Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth, as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.</p>

<p>Áve María, grátia pléna, Dóminus técum. Benedícta tū in muliériibus, et benedíctus frúctus véntris túi, Jesús. Sáncta María, Máter Déi, óra pro nóbis peccatóribus, nunc et in hóra mórtis nóstræ. Ámen.</p>	<p>Hail Mary, full of Grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the Fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and in the hour of our death. Amen.</p>

<i>Glory Be:</i>	
Glória Patri et Fílio et Spirítui Sancto. Sicut erat in princípío, et nunc et semper et in sæ´cula sæculórum. Amen.	Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.
<i>The Fatima Prayer:</i>	
O mi Jésu, dimitte nobis débita nostra, libera nos ab ígne inférni, Conduc in caelum omnes ánimas, praesertim illas, quae máxime indigent misericórdia tua.	O my Jesus, forgive us our sins save us from the fires of Hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy.
