WHEN: Saturday, January 26th. 8:30 AM - 6:00 PM

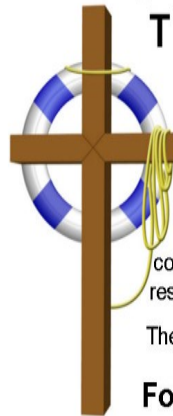
