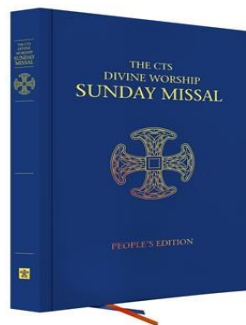
## Christmas Trees & Poinsettias
