Christmas is a time for generous hearts, and we are always humbled and grateful for the generosity of Our Lady of the Atonement parishioners. Please, keep your parish in your heart as you prayerfully consider your end-of-year giving. Thank you for all that you do for Our Lady of the Atonement. To help with your year-end giving planning, here are a few date and time reminders to consider.

IRS regulations require the following:

When mailing gifts, it is the **postmark date** which determines how the gift will be recorded, not the check date. Any envelope **postmarked through December 31** will be recorded for **2019**; any **postmark of January 1** or later will be recorded as **2020**, no matter the date on the check. Any checks received in our New Year's Day collection will be recorded for **2020** no matter the date on the check. The same is true for any gifts made via debit or credit card. **The transaction date must be prior to December 31 in order for the donation to be recorded as 2019.**

"Registration for the parish education program is ongoing but closes today, Sunday, Dec. 29. Registration forms can be found in the narthex. Each family should fill out one form, regardless of how long you have been here at the parish. Classes are set to begin Sunday, January 12 from 10:45-11:45 a.m. primarily in the upper school building (across from the gym). Materials will be provided to students.
