The church does not take a commission of sales (each artist is solely responsible for collecting and reporting all New Mexico sales tax). This year's theme is coinciding with Pope Francis' message for World Day of Peace, Jan 1, 2018, "Migrants and Refugees: Men and Women in Search of Peace."

- B. All traditional art work must be of Spanish Colonial period.

MARKET FEES

- Each artist must submit a completed application with payment by **September 14, 2018**
- Registration fee for both days is \$125 per adult artist

- Upon acceptance, artist will be notified via phone call; payment will be deposited and exhibit space assigned. Applicants who are not accepted will be notified via e:mail.

EXHIBIT SPACE:

Exhibit space will be assigned upon acceptance of application, based on the date received of a completed application, payment and availability. Space is limited- submit your application early. This year, San Felipe will supply the Tables, artists are required to supply their own tents/ set up.

Note: Artists must have been previously juried in past Santero Market events/years. If you have not been juried, you must provide 3 photos of your artwork and 1 photo of your booth set-up from a prior market, as well as a copy of your acceptance letter to the prior market.

ARTWORK DIVISION:

Note: No nontraditional crafts will be accepted or allowed for display

TRADITIONAL ART FORMS:

The Santero Market Committee requires traditional art forms. The following lists the traditional art forms as used by the Spanish Colonial Arts Society which has been adopted by the Santero Market:

- Santos bultos (carvings in the round) – depictions of religious figures in the forms
- Retablos (paintings on wooden panels), and gesso and wood relief-carved panels.
- Hide Paintings – religious images painted on deer, buffalo or elk hide.
- Encrusted Straw/Straw Applique – crosses, chests and boxes decorated with encrusted or applied straw
- Furniture – usually made from pine using mortise and tenon joints
- Colcha – unique regional embroideries employing the colcha stitch
- Tinwork – decorative and utilitarian objects of cut and punched tin
- Precious Metals – silver or gold jewelry, utilitarian and devotional objects
- Bonework – decorative items, anillos (rings) and tool handles carved from bones
- Weaving
- Pottery- Utilitarian objects made with micasons clay
- Handmade rosaries

DISCLAIMER/ACCEPTANCE: (Please read the following carefully before signing)

I have read and agree to abide by the rules of the San Felipe de Neri Santero Market. I understand I must exhibit and sell only my own **HANDMADE** work and I will uphold the standards established by the San Felipe de Neri Santero Market committee for the proper description and representation of my work. **Applicants must have been previously juried by the Santero Market committee. If artwork is found outside of the requirements you will be asked to remove them from your booth.**

In the event of inclement weather, or other causes beyond the control of the San Felipe de Neri Parish, prevents the Santero Market or any part thereof from being held, or is canceled by the Parish, the Parish shall determine and may elect to refund to the artist the proportionate share of the balance minus expenses incurred by the Parish for this event. The Parish shall not be liable for loss of profits, business, or other damages to the artist.

Furthermore, neither the Parish nor any of its officers, agents, employees, volunteers or other representatives shall be held accountable or liable for the same and are hereby released from accountability or liability for any damage, loss, harm or injury to the person or any property of the artist, or any of its officers, agents, employees, or other representatives resulting from theft, fire, water, accident or any other cause and the Parish will not obtain insurance against any such damage, loss, harm or injury.

Be prepared to participate in the Santero Market Mass, as it is an intricate focus of the market. We will not have security while you are in mass; make sure to bring someone who can take care of your booth while you are attending mass.
