Please read the following carefully: Each artist must submit an application with payment (credit card/money order/check) as follows:

- A. All traditional art work must be of Spanish Colonial period. Artists must have been previously juried in past Santero Market events or other traditional NM juried events. If you have not been juried, you must provide 3 photos of your artwork and depiction of your booth set-up.
- B. Completed application package, including application form and payment must be submitted and post marked no later than **Friday**, **September 13**, **2019 for inclusion in advertising**.
- C. Make check/money order payable to: San Felipe de Neri Parish. Sending payment does not guarantee acceptance into the market. If you are not accepted your payment will be refunded. You must receive Notification of Acceptance from Market Committee.

- Upon acceptance, artist will be notified via e:mail or phone call. Spaces are limited and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis, so submit your application early.
- Placement will be assigned by Committee prior to opening day.
- San Felipe will supply one table, two chairs. Artists are required to supply their own tents/ set up.

If artwork is found outside of the traditional artwork listed, you I be asked to remove it. Artists must agree to comply with Santero Committee direction.

In the event of inclement weather, or other causes beyond the control of the San Felipe de Neri Parish, which prevents the Santero Market or any part thereof from being held, or if the event is cancelled by the Parish, the Parish may elect to refund to the artist the proportionate share of the balance minus expenses incurred by the Parish for this event. The Parish shall not be liable for loss of profits, business, or other damages to the artist.

Furthermore, neither the Parish nor any of its officers, agents, employees, volunteers or other representatives shall be held accountable or liable for the same and are hereby released from accountability or liability for any damage, loss, harm or injury to the person or any property of the artist, or any of its officers, agents, employees, or other representatives resulting from theft, fire, water, accident or any other cause and the Parish will not obtain insurance against any such damage, loss, harm or injury. Security will not be provided. The option to store any property/ artwork overnight on the Parish property is prohibited.

Santeros are expected to participate in the Santero Market Mass, as it is an intricate intent of the market. The Parish will not have security while you are in church; make sure to bring someone who can take care of your booth while you are attending mass.
