## MESSAGE FROM FR. GABRIEL

The young man in the Gospel presents himself as a good person, who is seeking eternal life. He faithfully kept God's commandments since his youth and Jesus sees him full of love.

This is a clear example for us, the prototype of a true believer, but, nevertheless, Jesus asks him for more, a detachment from his material goods, and for him to share it with those in need.

Jesus showed him the most perfect and complete way to achieve his spiritual goal, he invited him to free himself from that form of attachment that until now, was separating him from his true and real wealth.

But, up to this point, this deep desire is beginning to fade because of a challenge that seems quite difficult and complex.

The possession of material goods, money and wealth are not bad, nor do they harm our progress towards eternal life, it is the way, the manner we manage, and how we use them in our human life and spirituality, and in the service of others.

The great problem is letting ourselves be carried away by material goods, by forgetting what our true wealth is and what we should aspire to. By believing we have earthly "riches" we enslave ourselves.

All that we are and have come from the providence and generosity of God, God is the father, owner and creator of all things. He grants us everything we ask for, through our honest and sincere works, we must cultivate in our life the adequate knowledge of salvation, to invest with prudence and justice.

Material things are meant to be tools to help us grow in generosity and service, to share in loving thanksgiving with a heart full of gratitude.

It is difficult for people who are overwhelmed by money and material ambitions to enter the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom belongs to the poor in spirit; (not economically poor) but detached from riches in the depths of their spirit, those who are capable of having much and sharing much, those who have abundantly and happily share generously.
