MESSAGE FROM FR. GABRIEL

Jesus establishes the demands of following from a second announcement of the Passion, which the disciples still do not understand, because they argue about "who is the most important."

They do not understand the meaning of the cross or the role of the latter. It was precisely on the cross that Jesus became the last, and in the resurrection he became the first. The disciples are reluctant to accept a community in which the first criteria are service and humility.

The teaching of Jesus invites a change of position, with the arrival of the Kingdom the schemes of this world have been changed: the last will be the first; the poor will be satisfied; those who lose their life are gaining it; and those who want to be the first must be the last and the servants of all.

This message is addressed to the entire community, but essentially for those who have a responsibility within it.

The desire to improve, the desire to be the first, the desire for triumph and success in life ... seem, in principle, legitimate aspirations of the human being; the problem, usually, is in the means we use to achieve these goals.

Jesus never said that we should not aspire to be the first, on the contrary: he invites us to be the first, but he shows us the only human and humanizing way to achieve it: love and service.
