

Daily Schedule:

- 7:25 - 7:45 **Arrival Activity (Usually Tracing/Writing) and Bathroom Reminders**
- 7:45 - 8:00 **Greeting**
(Good Morning Song, Calendar, Number Chain, Caterpillar Number, Weather, Flag)
- 8:00 - 8:15 **Gross Motor Song/Activity**
- 8:15 - 8:45 **Work Boxes** (on bottom shelf near outside door) + **Craft/Projects**
- 8:45 - 9:00 Video/Fine Motor: Poems & Songs/Finish-Up/Clean-Up
- 9:00 - 9:15 **Story & Sharing**
- 9:15 - 9:30 Handwashing, Warm Fuzzies and **Snack**
- 9:30-10:05 Free Play, Free Art and Center Choices (ANGELA BREAK- Feb./Mar.)
- 10:15-10:30 **Recess** (Only with ideal weather conditions) or **Gym**
(Change to outside shoes, unless Gym for weather reasons)
- 10:27 **Dismissal of Three-Year Olds**
(Someone will come or Aide can bring them to the front door for pick-up.)
- 10:30-10:40 **Continued Recess or Gym for Four-Year-Olds**
(One teacher sets up Small Group activity.
Keep outside shoes **on** for All-School Recess.)
- 10:45 - 11:15 **Small Group Activities** (Noted specifically on Weekly Plans)
- 11:15 - 11:25 **Rest/Lunch/Recess Readiness**
(Put mats out and use map on the cupboard door. Kids get blankets.)
- 11:25 - 11:52 **All School RecessMonday and Friday Recess Duty**
(-for Preschool Playground only. T-Th = Aide duty)
- 11:52 - 12:22 **Shoes, Bathroom & Hands, then Lunch at 11:57**
(Drop them off at their table, then take a teacher break until 12:28)
- 12:30 - 12:50 **Bathroom and Book Time**
(Give 5 min. to choose 2 books and stay on mats. They may not switch books.)
- 12:50 - 1:45 **Rest Time** (If 1-2 kids are awake at 1:20, they may color on their mats)
- 1:45 - 2:00 **Table Top Activities** (Quiet Activities for those who are already awake)
- 2:00 - 2:15 **Clean Up, Change Shoes and Bathroom (Wake all kids by 2:15)**
- 2:15 - 2:30 **Snack and Pack Folders and Lunches**
- 2:30 - 2:40 **Game or Story** (or Reading buddies until 2:50)
- 2:40 - 2:55 **Free Choice and/or Recess**
- 3:00 **Dismiss at Front Door** (Aide will take kids to ASC & Bus)

Centers:

(for class size over 12)

1. Listening on Blue Carpet... This usually takes about **10** min.
(..I put the CD player under my chair with headphones ready)
2. Usually Bingo Daubers, or Dry Wipe Cards
3. (Table closest to windows)
4. Coloring (Middle Table)
5. Independent Art Project (3rd brown table)
6. Teacher's Table (Semi-Circle Table)
***At Housekeeping, I put a special puzzle on the table or building toys for kids who are waiting for the Listening Center.

I set a 5 minute timer and use the Partner List.

The kids may stay at their center or go to the NEXT Center only.

After 10 minutes at the Center, they have to move on to the next Center.

You may have up to 6 kids at a center if the last group wanted to stay. If the last group of kids look like they are finished at a Center between the 5 and 10 minute timers, they may move on to the next Center.

You should be able to move the kids at the teacher table about 4+ times with transition times in between. I go to each Center and ask if they are staying or moving on to the very next, neighboring Center. There are only 2 Centers to choose from; 1 The one they want to stay at OR 2 The next one in line.

- At times, it is necessary for kids to skip the Listening Center and go directly to the brown table close to the windows. Then, when Listening is finished, I switch those two groups, so the ones who skipped can now go back and listen.
- Everyone else HAS to go to the next Center.
