



COVID-19 Preparedness Plan Addendums

Masks

-Medical exemption waivers will only be accepted if signed by a licenced physician.
(September 2020)

-Beginning on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 (SMV has no school 10/5/2020) students in kindergarten-fourth grade will be required to wear face masks throughout the school day as directed by the Governor. The preschool class is not included at this time. Students in fifth and sixth grade will continue to wear masks throughout the day, as stated in our preparedness plan. (September 2020)

-Students in Young 5's/Kindergarten through sixth grade are required to wear face masks throughout the school day. The preschool class is not included at this time.
(October 2020)

Travel

Employees and students who have traveled must evaluate precautions used during travel, experiences during travel, and during family/friend gatherings, to assess the need to stay home and monitor for symptoms for 14 days upon return from travel or gatherings (November 2020).

Staff members that choose to get vaccinated no longer have to quarantine following travel. (May 2021)

Gathering (School)

Parents may join the students and staff for school events taking place outdoors. In the event of poor weather and the event moves indoors, the event will remain staff and students only. (May 2021)

K-6 Mask Mandate

As of 5:00pm on September, 30, 2021 the wearing of masks at school will become a family choice. Senate Bill 82, section 1222 part 4, any health department that has issued an emergency order under MCL 333.2453 in an attempt to combat COVID-19 will lose funding for essential local public health services. (September 2021)
