

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Do I have to be Catholic to attend the retreat?

A. This is a Catholic retreat open to non-Catholics.

Q. I've been on a retreat. Why would I go on ACTS?

A. This type of retreat is totally different than any other retreat you have attended. The purpose of the retreat is to both embrace the individual's spirituality and enrich the parish as a community. The other benefits of ACTS can be explained easier by calling the director whose number is on this form.

Q: I've been on retreats where you have to share and tell everyone about yourself. I'm a private person and don't feel comfortable talking to strangers about personal issues.

A: How much or how little to share or participate is totally up to you.

Q. I'm concerned that the other women on the retreat will all know each other and I will feel left out.

A. It won't take long before you feel part of the group. The activities of the retreat will place you in a situation to meet a variety of new friends. You will not leave feeling "left out," but most likely will feel that you have many new sister's in Christ.

Q: I would like a friend from another parish to attend, can she go?

A: Space is limited, but we do have spaces open on a first-come basis for those outside the parish. The key is getting your registration form in early.
