

Church Use Schedule

1. Churches are reopening on a partial and limited basis for daily Mass beginning on Monday, June 8, 2020 and for Sunday Mass with anticipated Masses beginning on June 13, 2020.
 - a. The new schedule follows the diocesan regulation of limiting attendance to no more than 25% of the church seating capacity and ensuring physical distancing of at least 6 feet.
 - b. Because there will be fewer Masses and limited seating, registration will be required for weekend Masses. **You must register in advance for a Mass at www.neighborsnorth.org.** This is the surest and fastest way to register. For those without internet access, you can call (412) 219-9254 to leave your information (name, telephone number, Mass date, time and location you wish to attend and number of people attending with you).
2. The obligation to attend Mass continues to be suspended.
 - a. Mass will continue to be recorded and available on the website.
 - i. Because Incarnation is set up with wiring and equipment to record the Mass, it will not be open for the public celebration of Mass.
 - b. While we are delighted to welcome people back, parishioners should, with peace of mind, not attend Mass if they:
 - i. have any symptoms of Covid-19,
 - ii. have been with someone with the coronavirus within the past 14 days, or
 - iii. are uncomfortable with the risks associated with being in a large gathering.
3. Our priority is the safety of people by providing a clean and sanitized environment.
 - a. This requires at least three hours between any two services in the same church to allow time for cleaning and sanitizing surfaces.
 - b. To aid in this effort, churches are being designated for particular uses, for example, Incarnation for baptisms (the font is in the back of the church), Saint Teresa for funerals and memorial Masses, Saint Athanasius for private prayer, confessions and adoration and Saint Sebastian for daily Mass.
4. We know this adjustment can be difficult, but we are all in this together.
 - a. Everyone will need to be patient.
 - i. There may be lines on weekends as registrations are verified. Weather may be inclement so bring an umbrella.
 - ii. Not all doors will be used for both entering and exiting. Some doors will be designated as “Entrance Only”; others will be designated for “Exit.”
 - b. Everyone needs to play his or her part in reducing risk such as wearing a mask, maintaining physical distance and following protocols and directions.
 - c. This is an evolving situation and these interim plans can and will be adjusted as needed.
