All Masses in the Diocese of Pittsburgh Cancelled

In light of increasing updates on and concerns about the coronavirus (COVID-19), Bishop David Zubik has made the decision to cancel all weekday and Sunday Masses in the Diocese of Pittsburgh **effective Monday, March 16, 2020**, until further notice.

“Although in many ways it saddens me to make this decision, given the best advice from health experts on federal, state, and local levels, I feel it is a necessary one at this time. I’m relying on the understanding and cooperation of all in the Diocese of Pittsburgh as we pray for each other at this difficult time,” Bishop Zubik said.


