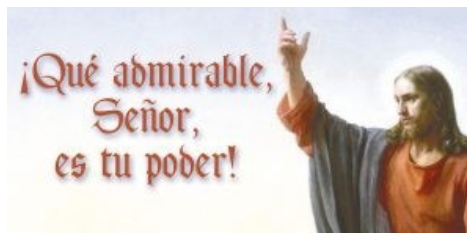

las marcas de esa misma cruz.

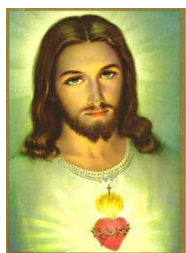
