

NO MORE MISSALETTES

COVID19 has changed the way we worship in many ways. All of our song books and missalettes have been removed from the church to prevent the spread of germs. Many of you picked up one of our missalettes for your personal use. Those missalettes expire at the end of November this year and, due to budget constraints and the uncertainty of pandemic restrictions, we are not purchasing more.

If you like to have a copy of the prayers and scriptures for participation in the Mass, what are your options?

1. **Access** the daily readings from the [USCCB website](#) (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops). You can view the daily readings on line or signup to have them delivered to your email inbox.
2. **Download** a FREE weekly participation guide from our [parish website](#). The guide is completely bilingual and provides links to the Sunday scripture readings on the USCCB website.
3. **Download a smart phone app**, such as *IBreviary* or *Laudate*, both of which are FREE, offer multiple languages, and provide daily readings, the order of Mass, prayers and antiphons.
4. **Subscribe** to a monthly missal, such as [Magnificat](#) or [Give Us This Day](#). They offer daily prayers, scriptures, and reflections. Both are available in print or online editions. A yearly subscription is about \$45.
5. **Purchase** a Sunday or Daily Missal for yourself. A paperback annual Sunday Missal can be purchased from the local church goods store for less than \$5.

No matter the option you choose, this is an opportunity to spend time with the scriptures. Read the Sunday or daily scriptures before you participate in Mass, or as part of your family meal prayer. Make the scriptures part of your daily life and open your heart to hear God's voice.
