Share The Love Of Christ To Our Visitors This Easter!

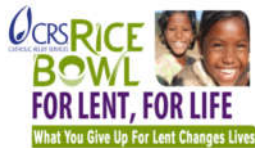

**The Blessing of Easter Food
during Morning Prayer on Holy Saturday
at St. Elizabeth of Hungary Church
Saturday, April 20, 9:00 – 9:30 a.m.**

We invite you to assemble a basket with hard boiled eggs, bread, and other Easter foods and bring it to church on Holy Saturday morning to be blessed and then shared at your Easter Sunday dinner. In earlier times, meat and dairy products were excluded from the daily diet during the entire season of Lent. As the end of the strict fast approached, people showed their joy and gratitude by taking their food to church to be blessed. On Holy Saturday, it is the custom for people in Eastern and Central Europe to bring decorated baskets of prepared food for the Easter meal to church. The priest blesses this food, which will be eaten to mark the end of the penances of Lent and the celebration of the Resurrection. Because this food is blessed, it should be consumed at your Easter meals and not discarded.

We encounter Jesus this week in Jerusalem, a community he knew well. We prayerfully enter our own communities too, encountering those who are hungry and thirsty, and those who need our help.
