The RCIA program will start on Monday, September 14th, in the parish hall.

The meetings will be held on Monday evenings from 7:30 to 9:00 pm. The RCIA program is directed to non-baptized adults who want to become Catholic, to non-Catholic baptized Christians who want to be received into the Catholic Church, and to adults who, though baptized Catholic, have not yet received the sacraments of First Communion and/or Confirmation. It is also offered to fully initiated Catholics who want to deepen the knowledge and understanding of their faith. The course covers all the main aspects of the Catholic faith, and it is meant to help growing in faith and friendship with Christ within the context of the Parish life. Anyone interested to join is invited to contact the office or visit the website of the Parish. Registration is open until the last Sunday of September. **Registration fee: \$ 50.**
