Spiritual Communion

Spiritual Communion is the heartfelt desire to receive Our Lord, even when we are unable to because of the distance or for some other reason. St. Thomas Aquinas reminds us that, *"The effects of a sacrament can be received by desire. Although in such a case the sacrament is not received physically...nevertheless the actual reception of the sacrament itself brings with it fuller effect than receiving it through desire alone."* Below please find a beautiful prayer from St. Alphonsus Liguori, that you can say in order to receive Christ through spiritual Communion when you are not able to be in the Eucharistic presence of the Lord.

*My Jesus,
I believe that You
are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.
I love You above all things,
and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment
receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if you were already there,
and unite myself wholly to You.
Never permit me to be separated from You.
Amen.*
