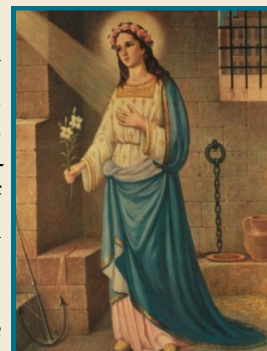
THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE
