The link will be at the bottom of this page, but before you go there, we like to provide you with the following information to assist you with the selection of gifts and navigating the site:

- We have provided a table below listing the organizations that are participating, who they help and what they need
- The link will take you the site which lists the organizations and the specific gifts needed (a gift requested is called a "Spot")
- Once you select a gift from an organization of your choice, you will be prompted to enter your e-mail address. Please do so, you will be sent a confirmation detailing:
  - the organization and item to purchase
  - detailed instruction for returning the gift(s) back to St. Bart's or to have your online purchase sent directly to the organization  
(Note: The Missionaries of Charity is the only organization unable to receive gifts sent to them directly)
- **We respect your right to privacy:**
  - the Participant Information screen will ask you for your name and telephone #, we ask that you fill these items as follows: name = XX and telephone # = 000 000 0000.
  - Within this same screen there will be three boxes selected to send third party information to you via e-mail, please unselect these three items (we apologize for this inconvenience)
- You now have the ability to select a gift from a different organization
