As a school family, we remain committed to assisting you in the educational journey of your children. This letter includes important dates, uniform discounts and information regarding the 2019-20 school year. Please do not hesitate to call with any questions you may have regarding our school.

Uniforms may be purchased from Beau's School Uniforms at 9027 W. Judge Perez Drive, Path at 2407 Paris Road, or Uniforms Plus at 2201 Paris Road. Our shoes are solid black tennis and can be purchased at Ponseti's in Clearview Mall. **Pre-K, K, and first grade** students must have Velcro black tennis shoes or Mary Janes. Uniform socks should be purchased from Beau's, Path, or Uniforms Plus; no other socks (except PK 3) should be worn. The girl's sweatpants may only be worn under the girls' skirts in the months of December, January, and February during very cold conditions. Ponseti's, Path, and Uniforms Plus offer a discount for Our Lady of Prompt Succor families. Ponseti's discount is available during July with the enclosed flyer; the discount for Path and Uniforms Plus is available with the coupon enclosed through June 30.

Also available is online ordering of school supplies for each grade level through School Tool Box. By June 10, visit our website (www.olpsschool.org) for more information.

Students in Pre-Kindergarten 3, 4, and Kindergarten are required to purchase nap mats. Be sure the mats are all in one—pillow, blanket, and mat, must be easy to roll up and stay closed, and is 20" x 40" in width and length and includes a carrying handle. If you would like to personalize the nap mats or tote bags, Sandy's Kustom Embroidery will personalize for \$5 per name per item. You may bring the items to school for personalization by Sandy by July 17. By June 10, visit our website (www.olpsschool.org) for more information.

On another note, students should have appropriate haircuts (no artificial coloring) and refrain from wearing any makeup effective the first day of school. Students in grades 1-7 will gather in the gym for morning prayer on Monday, August 5 no later than 7:45 AM. Dismissal is 3:00 PM. All gates remain locked during the school day 6:30 AM to 6:00 PM. Entrance is through the ELC for parents walking with their children. Parents who are coming to the assembly are asked to go through the car line to drop off their children and then park in the church parking lot. Parents parking their cars in the church parking lot may enter through the gym as long as their students have been dropped off first.

Enclosed you will find a copy of our supply list for your grade level, and it is also listed on our website (www.olpsschool.org). Please bring these items when you visit for our School Supply Drop Off Day for grades 1-7 on Friday, August 2, 2019 from 2:00-6:00 PM. You may use the enclosed form to order pencil cases, assignment pads, spirit shirts, or magnets. All orders submitted by July 17 should be available on August 2.

Each summer we require students in grades 1-7 to read one book and take an AR test the first week of the 2019-20 school year. This test will **not** count as a reading test grade; however, a project or report may be required. The required reading books are listed by grade level for 2019-20:
